

## SUMMARY OF AMENDMENTS EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2009

Local Rule/ General Order Number	Change in Local Rule.
General Order # 4	Language of General Order # 4 (Substitution of Custodian in all In Rem Proceedings) will be incorporated into Local Rule 64.1. General Order #4 will be abrogated.
General Order #10	Language of General Order #10 (Registry Funds into Interest Bearing Accounts) will be incorporated into Local Rule 67.1(d)1. General Order #10 will be abrogated.
General Order #11	Language of General Order #11 (Motion Return Date substitution in Pro Se Matters) will be incorporated into Local Rule 7.1. General Order #11 will be abrogated.
General Order #19	Language of General Order #19 (Jury Trials for Bankruptcy Judges) will be incorporated into Local Rule 76.1. General Order #19 will be abrogated.
General Order #20	Language of General Order #20 (Prohibition of Cash Bail) will be incorporated into Local Rule of Criminal Procedure 57.2. General Order #20 will be abrogated.
General Order # 29	Language of General Order #29 (Processing of Sealed Documents Following the Closure of a Civil Case) will be incorporated into Local Rule 83.13. General Order #29 will be abrogated.
General Order # 31	General Order #31 will be abrogated and the changes proscribed therein will be incorporated into the Local Rules.
General Order #32	General Order #32 will be abrogated and the changes proscribed therein will be incorporated into the Local Rules.
Local Rule 83.1	Clarify that attorneys admitted to the highest court in the state in which they reside, may seek permanent admission to the NYND bar.
Local Rule 83.3(g)	Increases the maximum reimbursement amount for assigned <i>Pro Bono</i> attorneys from \$1,200 to \$2,000.
Local Rule 83.4(j)	Clarifies amount of deference to be given to NY attorney disciplinary rules.
Local Rule 83.8	Local Rule 83.8, which limits parties in a patent case trial to one expert witness, will be eliminated.
