### *“The Impact of Addiction on Federal Criminal Practice”*

This program will focus on issues relating to addiction and how they impact the federal criminal justice system. Our keynote speakers will be Elizabeth Berry, Ph. D., and Monika Taylor, LCSW, CASAC of Crouse Hospital, who have a wealth of experience in treating criminal defendants suffering from substance addictions.
